

Special School Board Meeting  
December 4, 2006

A special school board meeting of the Redbank Valley School Board was held, Monday, December 4, 2006, 7:00 P.M., Redbank Valley High School Library Room. The following members were in attendance: Dee Bell, Louise Clemens, Vince Markle, Theodore Minich, Shirley Pastor, Lou Ann Williams and Glenn Watson. Kim Walls was absent.

The meeting was called to order by Theodore Minich, President. Mr. Minich announced that the special meeting was called for the election of an individual to the vacant school board director seat for Region II comprising of Porter Township, Oak Hall Independent and New Bethlehem Borough held by Jeffrey Merwin who resigned on November 6, 2006. The school board elected to accept letters of interest and resume from people within the region and conducted interviews on November 20, 2006 of interested candidates for the unfilled 1-year term.

Mr. Minich asked for a motion from the floor for a nomination of a candidate.

A motion was made by Lou Ann Williams seconded by Louise Clemens to nominate Randy Frampton for the vacant school board seat for the unfilled 1-year term.

Mr. Minich then asked for additional nomination. No additional nomination was made.

A motion was made by Lou Ann Williams seconded by Louise Clemens that the nominations for the vacant seat be closed. Motion Carried Unanimously

The Board Secretary cast a roll call vote, Motion passed Unanimously, Randy Frampton was elected to the Redbank Valley School Board for the vacant seat in Region II for the remaining 1-year term.

Mr. Minich gave the oath of office to Mr. Frampton and congratulated him on his election to the school board. Dr. Cornish then thanked the other candidates Anne Callenburg and Jeffrey Hornberger for there interest in serving the school board.

At 7:08P.M. Mr. Minich called the special meeting adjourned.
