124. SUMMER SCHOOL	
1. Authority SC 502, 1901, 1906 Title 22 Sec. 4.41	<p>It is the policy of the Board that the district may conduct a summer program of instruction at the primary level, intermediate level, middle school level, high school level for resident students of this district and such other students as permitted.</p> <p>In order to support a program of summer instruction, the Board shall:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Employ teaching and administrative staff.2. Purchase necessary books, materials, supplies, and equipment.3. Utilize schools or other facilities required.4. Provide necessary custodial services. <p>Courses offered in summer school may be designed as credit or noncredit offerings.</p>
2. Guidelines	<p>Students eligible for the district's summer school shall include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Resident students who are eligible for regular attendance in the public schools of this district.2. Students eligible by standards established by the governmental funding source.3. Nonresident students whose age or grade level is appropriate to the course of study applied for. <p>Tuition fees established by the Board shall be charged to secondary students. A tuition waiver/reduction program is available for eligible students.</p>
3. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Superintendent or designee shall be responsible for:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Planning the summer school curriculum.

Evaluation and reporting on pupil progress.5. Utilization of facilities.6. Regulations for student behavior. <p>Regulations for the operation of summer school shall be consistent with Board policies, and the operation of summer school shall not conflict in any way with the administration of the regular school sessions of this district.</p>
