ASSIGNMENT WITHIN DISTRICT</p> <p>The Board directs that the assignment of students to classes and schools within this district be consistent with the proper education of students and best use of district resources.</p> <p>The administration has been directed by the Board to reassign students from one attendance area to another for the purpose of class equalization, elimination and other educational opportunities in to the best interests of the students and the district.</p> <p>Unordinary circumstances, such as a large number of students being considered for reassignment, shall have prior Board approval.</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee may assign a student to a school other than that designated in the attendance area when such exception is justified by circumstances and is in the proper educational interest of the student.</p> <p>Resident students who move into the district are enrolled at the school which they will attend. Any student whose residence is in question should be referred to the building principal.</p> <p>The building principal shall assign students in his/her school to appropriate grades, classes, or groups. This action shall be based on consideration of the needs and abilities of the student as well as the administration of the school.</p>
